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Notice to Candidates – 2026

Nominations for election to the Board close at **11am on Saturday the 7th of February 2026**. Nominations are to be returned to the Secretary, care of the Office. Nominations must be made in writing (58a). Nominations submitted by post must arrive at the Post Office box, no later than Friday 6th of February 2026.

Candidate: The nominee must be a financial Ordinary, or Honorary Life Member, for a period of three (3) current and consecutive years at the close of nominations (58b). Associate members are ineligible to be nominated to the Board (14).

Proposer & Seconder: At the close of nominations the proposer and seconder must be financial and have a minimum of three (3) current and consecutive years of membership of ARNSW (58d). It is the responsibility of the candidate to find their own proposer and seconder, and to ensure that they are Ordinary, or Honorary Life Members.

Resume: With the ballot papers, candidate resumes will be sent out to members. The resumes are to be a maximum of 200 words and are to be forwarded to the Secretary, within three days after the close of nominations (Tuesday 10th of February 2026). The resumes can be forwarded to the Office by post or by e-mail to elections@arnsw.org.au. The Secretary reserves the right to edit any resumes over 200 words.

Scrutineer: Each candidate is entitled to appoint a scrutineer to observe the count of ballots. The count will take place in the afternoon (time to be determined) of Friday 20th March 2026 at VK2WI, 63 Quarry Road Dural. Any candidate who wishes to appoint a scrutineer, but is unable to find one, should contact the returning officer and he may be able to assist by suggesting a few names.

Requirements under Corporations Act 2001: Candidates must be eligible to be a company officeholder as defined in the Act, including the requirement to have a Director ID prior to being appointed to the Board.
